



Indian auto LPG coalition appeals for level playing field for auto LPG

NEW DELHI : Indian Auto LPG Coalition (IAC) has appealed to the Prime Minister to endorse Auto LPG as an environmentally friendly alternative fuel and provide a level playing field. In his letter, Suyash Gupta, Director General of Indian Auto LPG Coalition, highlighted the substantial environmental and economic benefits of adopting Auto LPG over traditional fuels. Auto LPG, as a clean-burning fuel, significantly reduces emissions of harmful pollutants such as particulate matter, nitrogen oxides, and carbon dioxide, leading to improved air quality and a reduced carbon footprint. This positions Auto LPG as a "Net Zero Hero," aligning with India's international environmental commitments and sustainable development goals. Gupta in his letter stated, "Auto LPG offers significant environmental advantages, emitting 20 per cent less CO2 than petrol and 60 per cent less than diesel. It produces almost no particulate matter, a major contributor to air pollution, and has significantly lower nitrogen oxide emissions. Regarding energy security, India imports LPG from multiple countries, ensuring a stable and secure supply chain, which contributes to energy independence."

"Additionally, Auto LPG is around 40 per cent cheaper than petrol, and the conversion cost for a petrol vehicle to Auto LPG is approximately Rs 30,000, significantly lower than the costs for an EV and even the conversion costs for CNG."

Indian Auto LPG Coalition has been a strong advocate for cleaner fuel alternatives, engaging with policymakers to integrate Auto LPG into the sustainable development framework. Gupta emphasized the need for supportive fiscal policies that recognize Auto LPG's role in achieving India's environmental and economic goals.

He added, "Huge success of the Ujjwala Yojana has improved LPG infrastructure availability across the country, ensuring a stable supply chain for Auto LPG. Globally, Auto LPG has seen substantial growth, with over 27 million vehicles using it and 25 million tonnes consumed annually."

The IAC calls for greater inclusion of Auto LPG in the national policy framework for cleaner fuels, alongside the EVs and CNG.

They propose tax incentives and benefits to encourage Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) to produce Auto LPG variants.

Furthermore, they suggest reducing the GST rate on Auto LPG from 18 per cent to 5 per cent to make it more affordable and align it with the GST rate on domestic LPG.

Union Minister Mansukh Mandaviya chairs meeting on employment data, overseas emigration trends in Delhi



NEW DELHI : Union Minister of Labour & Employment, Mansukh Mandaviya, chaired a high-level meeting in New Delhi on key issues related to employment data and overseas emigration trends. Union Minister of State for Labour and Employment, Shobha Karandlaje, was also present at the meeting, which took place on Monday. The deliberations with the

Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and NITI Aayog aimed to strengthen coordination and data assimilation for both overseas employment and domestic job creation, as well as to enhance the monitoring of recruiting agencies and skill requirements for employment abroad," the Ministry of Labour & Employment said in a statement.

Mandaviya highlighted the need for a mechanism to have complete data on citizens going abroad for jobs and studies in ECR and non-ECR countries. He also suggested that there should be an integration of the National Career Service (NCS) portal, MY Bharat Platform, MADAD, eMigrate, eShram portals, state portals for a comprehensive

view of the supply and demand side of employment. He further emphasized that industry associations can play a pivotal role in collating employment data. The Minister underscored the role of NITI Aayog as an umbrella organization that can facilitate the compilation of employment-related data from various ministries.

"Cannot act as rajas": CPI leader urge Congress to learn from Haryana defeat

NEW DELHI : CPI MP P Sandosh Kumar on Tuesday described the results of Jammu and Kashmir Assembly polls as "very happy news," and cautioned the Congress leaders to not act as "mass leaders" or "rajas."

Kumar urged the Congress party to learn from the election outcomes. "As a political party that leads the India alliance, Congress should learn more lessons," he said, noting that some Congress leaders act as if everything is under their control, which he described as misleading.

"The Congress should understand the gravity of the situation, and some of its leaders should be down to earth. They cannot act as rajas and big mass leaders. They should understand the reality. That is how in Haryana they got defeated," he added.

In a significant comeback, the National Conference and Congress alliance has secured victory in the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly elections, according to the Election Commission's official

website. As the vote counting concluded, the Election Commission declared the total number of seats won by each party. The Jammu and Kashmir National Conference (JKNC) emerged as the largest party with 42 seats, followed by the BJP with 29 seats and Congress with 6 seats.

Notably, seven independent candidates have won from their respective constituencies.

The Kerala MP emphasised that the threat posed by the BJP and RSS is still significant. "It is not like that. Congress should understand that the menace of BJP and RSS is not over. Its duty is to coordinate all possible forces," he said. He also highlighted the need for better collaboration within the alliance, mentioning that the CPI was expected to receive at least one seat from Congress but faced obstacles in doing so.

"The CPI was supposed to receive at least one seat from the Congress party. We may be a minor force, I agree, but when you are in an alliance,

there must be proper understanding and mutual support", said the CPI leader.

Regarding the Jammu and Kashmir elections, Kumar claimed that the results indicate the people of Kashmir have rejected the policies of the BJP government, particularly about the abrogation of Article 370. "The results of Jammu and Kashmir are very happy news for all of us because this election assumes importance. This is after the abrogation of Article 370, and it is evident that the people of Kashmir rejected the policies of the BJP government, no doubt at all," he added.

Kumar also claimed that the BJP is still trying to control Jammu and Kashmir from the central level. "BJP at the central level is controlling the people of Jammu and Kashmir, and I think even after these election results, they may try to control the state through their channels," he said.

He also called for the immediate restoration of statehood for Jammu and

Kashmir, reiterating that this demand has existed since the abrogation of Article 370. "We demand the immediate restoration of the statehood of Jammu and Kashmir. I think these election results are an eye-opener to the BJP government at the centre, and they should concede this demand," he added.

As per the latest update from the Election Commission's website in the ongoing Haryana Legislative Assembly elections, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has emerged as the leading party, securing 37 seats and leading in 12 more, for a total of 49 seats.

The Indian National Congress (INC) follows closely, having won 31 seats and leading in five others, bringing their total to 36 seats. The Indian National Lok Dal (INLD) has won one seat and is leading in one more constituency. Additionally, Independent candidates have won three seats. The Assembly has 90 seats, with results declared.

Assam: Sarbananda Sonowal shares 'Poori Sabji' with rickshaw and cart pullers in Dibrugarh

DIBRUGARH : Union Minister of Ports, Shipping & Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, met with rickshaw and cart pullers in Dibrugarh on Tuesday. According to an official statement, the Dibrugarh MP interacted with the workers and shared a meal of Poori Sabji with them. Speaking on the occasion, Sonowal said, "The objective of Narendra Modi's government is to empower and enable every person in society through the Antyodaya philosophy, which ensures equal development with dignity for everyone. Your hard work has always supported the local economy." "It has been a privilege to meet all of you today during this beautiful Durga Puja season. I enjoyed having Poori Sabji with our Shramik brothers, as it reminded me of my childhood", the MP added. Earlier in the day Union Minister Sarbananda Sonowal had exuded confidence in BJP winning both of these Assembly elections.

Crucial top Army brass meet in Sikkim this week, Defence Minister to address



NEW DELHI : In a strong message to China, the top brass of the Indian Army led by Gen Upendra Dwivedi would be meeting in Sikkim near the Line of Actual Control, where they would be addressed by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh. This is the first time that the crucial meeting of the top Army commanders would be held at a location close to the Line of Actual Control, defence officials told ANI. The meeting planned to be held in Sikkim from October 10-11 would be addressed by the top defence brass including Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, they said.

The meeting would be taking stock of the sensitive situation along the LAC especially in Ladakh and Arunachal Pradesh where the two sides have been getting engaged in stand offs and face-offs on a regular basis. The second phase of the conference is likely to be

held in Delhi on October 28-29.

The top brass would also discuss the lessons of the ongoing global conflicts and the lessons to be drawn for the Indian forces including the different arms of the Army, the officials said.

This would also be the first meeting of the top Army commanders under the leadership of Gen Dwivedi who took over as the Chief of Army Staff on June 30 this year.

The second phase of the meeting would be held in Delhi also around the end of the month, the sources said.

Recently, Gen Dwivedi had stated that the situation with China on the borders was stable but not normal.

He had also pointed out that trust between the Indian Army and the Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA) was "the biggest casualty" of the dragging military standoff with China in the sensitive theatre.

Uttar Pradesh: Govt organises 'Kumbh summit' across the state

LUCKNOW : In the run up to the Mahakumbh 2025, the UP government launched a 'Kumbh Summit' on Tuesday across eighteen tehsils of the state. Additionally, the state government also highlighted 'Kumbh Abhinandan' road show which started from GPO Park and concluded at Marine drive earlier today (Tuesday). Maha Kumbh 2025, a mega event is set to take place from January 14 to February 26, 2025.

The culture and tourism minister said that Prime Minister is also planning to visit the various sites in Prayagraj where Kumbh mela is going to take place.

Culture and Tourism Minister Jaiveer Singh said that along with the Kumbh Summit, the government is going to organise Bal-Yuva Kumbh, Kala-Sanskriti Kumbh, Kavi Kumbh, Bhakti Kumbh across the 18 tehsils of the states.

"Preparations have been made to organise all those events. Lalit Kala Academy has been given the responsibility to organise the art and photography exhibition. Sangeet Natak Academy is given the responsibility to organise singing and dancing competition," he said during a press conference.

He further urged the people assist people in spreading the message of the Kumbh mela and promote the values the mela represents. "This is not just government's program, it is successful because of common people's program. So whoever is a sanatani believer, meaning anyone who stays in India, so for the success of the program, whatever assistance could be given in whatever form would be helpful," the state culture and tourism minister said. Earlier on October 6, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said that the government has set a deadline of December 15 to provide all the facilities to the devotees participating in the Mahakumbh Mela 2025 in Prayagraj. He also said that the government is using AI tools to ensure safety, focusing on 'zero plastic usage' and expanding the area of the fiesta.
